What does the test show?

- This test will show how well the blood flows through the heart muscle.

What will happen throughout my visit?

- For the stress portion, you will either be walking on the treadmill or medications will be injected to imitate exercise.
- A consent form will need to be signed. Females below the age of 50 will need to sign a consent form stating they are not pregnant. If there is a possibility of pregnancy, we will request a pregnancy test be performed.
- For one day testing please plan on being in the office for 2-3 hours; two day testing 1.5 hours **Nuclear**

Stress Test Preparation Instructions:

- To provide very good care and protect your privacy, family members will be asked to remain in the waiting room. If you bring children, you must bring someone to supervise them in the waiting room while your test is performed.
- **No caffeinated OR decaffeinated products for at least 24 hours prior to your test, including:**
-- Coffee -- Chocolate -- Tea --Soda --Migraine medications (such as Excedrin/Anacin) **Drink plenty of water the day before and the day of your test.**
- Please do not eat **2 hours prior to a nuclear test.** Unless you're diabetic. If you have diabetes, please eat at your scheduled meal times.
- For respect of your safety, **please wear closed toe/closed heel walking shoes** and a comfortable two piece outfit. **No** dresses please.
- To provide very good care, please do not use any body lotions or oils on the chest area the day of the test.

Medication Instructions:

☐ Please **hold** your beta blocker _____ for 24 hours prior to your appointment; take all other medication as prescribed.
